### INSTRUCTIONS

1. No requests for change in examination centre, date, or session will be entertained under any circumstances.
2. Candidates should bring a print of the admit card. Admit Card must be printed on A4 size paper using a laser printer. The Admit Card is valid only if the candidate's photograph and signature are clearly printed and not smudged or damaged.
3. The Admit Card is valid only for the test date and session mentioned on it. It is not transferable to any other date, session, or test centre.
4. The Admit Card is provisional, subject to the candidate fulfilling all eligibility criteria as stated in the official notification. The candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage if found ineligible.
5. Candidates must carry any one original, valid photo ID proof: Aadhaar Card, Voter ID, PAN Card, Passport, Driving License, or any other government-approved photo ID. The name on the ID must match the name on the Admit Card. In case of any discrepancy in the photograph on the Admit Card, candidates must carry one recent passport-size photograph.
6. Candidates must report to the test centre at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the examination. Entry will not be permitted after the gate closure time (09:30 AM).
7. Use or possession of electronic devices, jewelry, jackets, calculators, watches, or any metal-containing items is strictly prohibited inside the test centre.
8. All candidates will be subjected to mandatory frisking at the entry point. If any objectionable item is found, candidates will be asked to leave it behind. Non-compliance may result in debarment from the examination.
9. Guardians, relatives, or friends accompanying candidates will not be allowed inside the test centre premises.
10. Malpractice in any form will not be tolerated. The decision of the venue officials in case of any violation will be final and binding.
