- Average salary pm **Rs 5,35,000**

Germany



- 10,70,000 Nurse; **16% Foreign born**; 85% Women;
- Nurse **shortage** in country by 2030 ~ 5,20,000;
- Average salary pm **Rs 2,30,000**

England



- 5,17,200 Nurse; **15% Foreign born**; 89% Women;
- Nurse **shortage** in country by 2030 ~ 1,40,000;
- Average salary pm **Rs 4,35,000**

Ireland



- 58,475 Nurse; **28% Foreign born**; 91% Women;
- Average salary pm **Rs 3,15,000**
